Hebrews Chapter 2

Three Actions God is calling me to do now:

1. I must Listen Carefully to God.

Hebrews 2:1-4

Therefore we must give the more earnest heed to the things we have heard, lest we drift away.

Greek: Prosecho To hold the mind towards; To apply oneself to

James 1:22 But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves

Greek: “drift away” Pararrhuego to flow by, carelessly pass, miss

Hebrews 2:2

For if the word spoken through angels proved steadfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just reward,

Greek: Bebaios established, firm, punishment

1 Corinthians 10:5-6

But with most of them God was not well pleased, for their bodies were scattered in the wilderness.

Now these things became our examples, to the intent that we should not lust after evil things as they also lusted.

Greek: Tupos A stamp, shape

Romans 10:17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

2. I must open my eyes to See God around me.

Hebrews 2:4

God also bearing witness both with signs and wonders, with various miracles, and gifts of the Holy Spirit, according to His own will?

Acts 14:3

Therefore they stayed there a long time, speaking boldly in the Lord, who was bearing witness to the word of His grace, granting signs and wonders to be done by their hands.

Acts 7:36

He brought them out, after he had shown wonders and signs in the land of Egypt, and in the Red Sea, and in the wilderness forty years.

3. I must prepare myself for Jesus' Return

The world to come will be ruled by Jesus

Hebrews 2:5-8

For He has not put the world to come, of which we speak, in subjection to angels. But one testified in a certain place, saying:

Greek: Oikoumenee The inhabited world (under the Messiah)

*We do not see everything
under man's control at the present time...*

But, we do see Jesus!

Hebrews 2:9

But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone.

Philippians 2:6-8

...although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, 7 but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men.

Greek: Kenosis "Jesus stripped himself of the insignia of majesty."

Key Verse to Memorize this week:

Romans 10:17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.
